This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey approval of the Board for Fresh Affiliation up to Senior Secondary Level as per details given below :

<b>Sl. No.</b>	<b>The school is directed to ensure that :</b>
1	The total number of sections of the school from class I to XII shall be restricted to 12 of which not more than 2 sections may be used for senior secondary classes. The optimum number of students shall be restricted to 40 for classrooms size of 500 sq ft and above. Further, the increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board based on the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of classrooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension
2	The school is directed to run atleast 01 section each of bal-vatika I, II & III subject to the maximum bal-vatika permitted vide Board's circular no. 12/2023 dated 24-03-2023 & 25/2023 dated 11-09-2023.
3	The certificates of building safety and water sanitation have been submitted by the Minor Irrigation Department in place of an officer not below the rank of an Assistant Engineer of the Government Works Department and Public Health Department(PHED). Thus, the school is required to obtain to renewed certificates to be issued by concerned department within 03 months and submit the same in compliance.
4	As per the building safety certificate, the school has one basement, which is not suitable for conducting academic activities. Thus, the school is directed not to use the

	same for any academic activity and submit an undertaking in this regard on its letterhead within 03 months in compliance.
5	The school is required to appoint a qualified Special educator Counsellor and wellness teacher within 03 months and submit the appointment letters along with educational qualifications in compliance.
6	All three science labs are understocked and they do not have safety features such as fire extinguishers and exhaust fans. Further, the biology and physics labs are set up on makeshift tables with insufficient seating arrangements. The biology lab does not have washbasins ( with water taps). Also, the chemistry lab does not have gas connections in the workstations and seating arrangements (wooden stools). Thus, the school is required to upgrade the same in light of the Board's SoP for labs within 03 months and submit the compliance.
7	The composite science lab is set-up on the make-shift tables. It does not have permanent fixtures, washbasin (with water tap) as well as gas connection in the workstation, sufficient seating arrangement (wooden stools), sufficient storage facility and safety features such as fire extinguishers and exhaust fans. Thus, the school is required to setup as per the Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance
8	The computer lab has only 22 computers which is lesser than minimum requirement i.e. 40 computers as per Board's SoP and circular. Thus, the school is required to procure more computers within 03 months and submit the invoice along with videography in compliance.
9	The school is required to procure more books for the library and create a separate reading space for staff within 03 months and submit the videographic compliance.
10	The school has converted regular cubicles into CWSN toilets, but they are very narrow and there is no room for a wheelchair/walker to navigate. Thus, the school is required to construct the CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls on each floor with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair as well as handrail on both side of toilet seat (fixed and movable) and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPwD Act and board's guidelines within 03 months and submit the compliance.
11	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Noida within 03 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.

6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
